## Student Satisfaction Survey Report

S.Y.B.Ed 2017 – 18

### Analysis on students Response

A student satisfaction survey from the second year B.Ed. students. The survey items consisted of the students opinion about the way the various activities that were conducted in the college for year 2017 – 2018 and about the college staff.

All students were given a questions with 8 open ended items. The items were open ended to give the opportunity for the students to justify their performances and experiences. Their experience were taken to help the college plan out the activities for the next academic year. Given below report based on students feedback.

- 1) Which practical work most useful & satisfactory for you ?

The students found the practical Internship is very useful and beneficial. Being in the internship went through detail study of teaching learning process. Internship built their confidence and improved their teaching skills. They also mentioned thought they were very satisfied with the practical which helped them to read current researches on learning disabilities for acquainting them with the recent development in inclusive education. The practicum related to the elective course Environmental Education. were also found useful by the students as a future teachers. A special mention was made regarding understanding the self as it helped them in introspection and reflection. These were practicum work they found most satisfactory.

- 2) How satisfied were you with the class test & assignment in preparing for the final examination ?

The students found the class test & assignment very helpful and were very satisfied as they gave them a practice of writing answers. They also got an idea regarding what was expected to be written. Further it helped them to identify their strengths and limitations. This helped them plan and work on time management. They felt that because of class test & assignments they were able to go through the syllabus before hand and hand to only do revision before final examination.

- 3) Name the activities which you enjoyed the most and were satisfied with how they were conducted.

The students liked all the co – curricular activity competitions like poetry recitation competition, essay writing competition and rangoli competition. Many of them especially enjoyed the visit to Pratapgad, Bhilgaon (pustakachalaya). During sports day both indoor & outdoor games were enjoyable for many students. Students enjoyed the entire week of Annual social activities as it was a refreshing break for them. They were also satisfied with the opportunities they got to participate in them.

- 4) Describe your experiences during the internship. How was the second year internship different from the first year internship were you satisfied with the programme ?

Students found the second year internship very beneficial. According to them the second year internship helped build their confidence, hence there was an improvement in their teaching skill. The students also appreciated that they got to experience teaching in various schools like. Nutan Maratha Vidyalaya, Kolhapur, Sha Kru Pant Walawalkar High School, Kolhapur, Maharashtra high school Kolhapur. Some also mentioned that by second year they become more confident and accurate in writing their lesson notes. Thus having two years of internship was opined as extremely satisfaction and useful by the second year B.Ed. students.

- 5) How satisfied were you regarding the B.Ed. practicum.

- a) Understanding of self : The students found course to be beneficial as it taught them on important life skill related to self observation leading to understanding of self. This helped increase their confidence as a person and as a future teacher. It taught them how to reflect as self work. Further , they also appreciated the different activities that were conducted under this course indicating that they were vastly satisfied with the course.
  - b) Basic Research : This course helped students get acquainted with the concept in research . The also get on idea of the different ways of doing research hence educated their scientific approach. It also provided to be helpful in their students and were satisfied with the course.
  - c) Reading and reflecting on texts : The course helped students learn how to read and understand text. It was very comprehensive and rigorous dealing with different types of reading. Hence it was very informative and very satisfactory.
- 6) What types of guidance did you receive from your group in charge ?

Personal : The students appreciated the guidance received from their respective group in-charge. Though personal guidance the students developed confidence. They also mentioned that the group in charges were very co – operative cheerful and motivational.

Academic guidance given by the group in - charges were also acknowledged by the students. The students problem were cleared effectively and they learnt how to work systematically. Students were more than satisfied with the guidance them received from the group in charges.

- 7) What are your general opinion about the institute ?
- a) Principal : The students have a very high and excellent opinion regarding out respected principal Dr. Rajashri Deshpande. Many commendable qualities like being co –

operative , down to earth , pleasing personality , supportive approachable and kindhearted. Students felt proud to be a student of this institution because of person like Dr. Rajashri Deshpande is the leader of the institution. Hence the students were exceedingly satisfied with the conduct of the principal of the college.

- b) Lecturers : Reading the lecturers the students found them very co – operative, regular, knowledgeable and well qualified. They appreciated that some lecturer used group and technology to teach their courses. Many mentioned that the lecturers were motivating and caring. So the students acknowledged their satisfaction regarding the teaching staff.
- c) Non teaching staff : The students had a pleasant experience interacting with the office staff. In general they found the non teaching staff to be helpful , supportive , present and efficient.
- d) General Administration : The students had a very good opinion regarding general administration , indicating that there was an improvement in cleanliness. They also appreciated the facilities and equipment available for the students. In general they found the college staff understating perfect in their work and co – operative . Hence the students were very satisfied with overall working of the college.

- 8) What is your opinion regarding the two year B.Ed. programme ?  
The students had mixed opinion regarding the duration of B.Ed. programme. The pro and cons of the two year according to the students are as follows.
